

Dear fellow citizen,

3 November is the deadline for registering to vote for the first **Committee of Italians Abroad** (ComItEs) elections in Singapore.

We vote by post, but, unlike political elections and referendums, only those who explicitly request registration on the electoral roll will receive the electoral envelope. Therefore, we invite you to register to vote and not miss the opportunity to play an active role in the lives of our institutions.

The following pages explains the various registration methods. For your convenience, **you can download** <u>here</u> **a copy of the registration form**. It must be completed, scanned, and sent by e-mail to the embassy accompanied by a passport photocopy.

You can vote immediately after receiving the electoral envelope. The ballot paper must reach the embassy no later than 3 December 2021.

The ComItEs will be the spokesperson for the Italian community in relations with the embassy and will work to integrate Italians residing in Singapore. It will identify the social, cultural, and civil development needs of the community and deal with assistance to new residents, equal opportunities, the improvement of consular services, the promotion of the Italian language and culture, universities, and research.

We take this opportunity to invite you to read the presentation flyer of **our transparent and inclusive list, "Italiani in Singapore."** This list is born from a group of Italian residents' enthusiasm and desire to contribute. Albeit with different personal and professional profiles, we have the same goal at heart and are committed to putting our knowledge and free time at the community's disposal.

REGISTER TO VOTE!

Italian citizens residing in Singapore and registered with AIRE may register in the embassy's electoral roll by 3 November, through the Fast It Portal, by selecting the function dedicated to elections: "Application for registration in the electoral roll for the elections of the Comites." In addition, you can use the QR code below.



Alternatively, you can <u>download</u> and send the form:

- by sending it by ordinary e-mail (singapore.anagrafe@esteri.it) or certified (amb.singapore@cert.esteri.it), with a copy of an identity document, bearing the signature of the owner;
- delivering it in person to the Embassy offices (with an identity document);
- by sending it by paper mail together with a photocopy of an identity document containing the signature.

The list Italiani in Singapore is made up of multi-sector professionals with a strong desire to help the growth of the Italian community in Singapore!

Why vote ITALIANI IN SINGAPORE?

Representativeness of the local community: The list comprises professionals and entrepreneurs in solidarity to assist, through the Comites and in full transparency, the Italian community of Singapore to make it more cohesive and less fragmented. With substantial professional and human experience, the candidates work in multiple sectors such as food and beverage, transport, IT, finance, insurance, and research.

Permanence and roots: Many of the applicants have been residents in Singapore for several years and have "Permanent Resident" status and accurate knowledge of the local reality. Over 70% of applicants have been residents in Singapore for more than ten years.

Associativism: Singapore's small size facilitates personal and professional relationships. In this context, associations are fundamental, and the Italian community can also benefit from them. Therefore, the list includes both members of the Italian Association of Singapore and other Associations.



BY 3 NOVEMBER



The **deadline** for registration in the electoral roll via the FastIT portal or by sending the <u>form</u> via post or e-mail, with a photocopy of a valid document.

FROM 13 NOVEMBER



The Embassy will send you the electoral envelope. You can vote as soon as you have received the package. If you do not receive the package by November 20, contact the Embassy immediately.

3 DECEMBER



Deadline for the arrival of the ballot papers at the Embassy. Make sure you send your ballot in advance to avoid losing the opportunity to cast your vote!
